### ***Course Objectives***

At the end of this course, students will be able to:

- Create a column and set text attributes; add text in a path; add text along a path; convert text to paths; wrap text around an object; create a table by using tabs, paragraph rules, and column and row options; add rules between columns and rows; and create, select, and color a chart.
- Draw an arc by using the Arc tool, spray objects on a page by using the Graphic Hose tool, use the Expand Stroke and Connector tools and brush stroke attributes, create images by using the Variable Stroke Pen and the Calligraphic Pen tools.
- Use the Align panel to arrange objects; turn an object into a guide; find and replace objects; use the Inset Path tool; transform two-dimensional objects into three-dimensional objects; position images accurately; and erase paths.
